17 YEARS ON THE FRONT LINE OF CONSERVATION

What the Bukit Lawang Trust is Doing:

Here at the Trust we have a motto, "Sedikit demi sedikit lama lama menjadi bukit" - Little by little we climb the mountain. It speaks of our unfailing commitment to the protection and preservation of the natural world. The Bukit Lawang Trust has been working on the front line of Environmental Conservation for almost 17 years, here is some of the things we're doing;

- We've teamed up with the UN to deliver the 17 sustainable development goals!
- For many years now, the trust has partnered with Erna's Eco farm to help provide food security and education to local smallholder farmers on sustainable best practices.
- In partnership with Ibu Erna's Eco Farm we support the Tree Nursery there, and every volunteer plants 10 trees in the jungle to actively regrow the wild spaces in the Leuser.
- For 13 years the Trust has delivered free conservation education to children in the local communities surrounding Bukit Lawang.
- In partnership with Darwin Animal Doctors the Trust now trains the next generation of Jungle rangers as part of the Youth Ranger program!
- We've teamed up with a range of local reforestation initiatives to help offset our carbon emissions and those of our volunteers.
- Since 2016 the Bukit Lawang Trust has hosted the Conservation Festival in Bukit Lawang, North Sumatra. The Birthplace of many conservation program and initiative!
